

Consider serving on the Chamber board

At least seven new directors must soon be elected or appointed to the Rainsville Chamber's volunteer board. Six of them will serve a three-year term. Another one or two persons will be needed to complete the terms of directors who were not able to complete their three-year terms.

The Chamber board makes policy, financial and activity-related decisions. They help carry out a few of the organization's events and programs each year.

For the past several years the board

has met once per month at lunchtime. That trend is expected to continue but is not set in stone. In addition, each board member typically serves on up to two committees. Each committee meets from two to four times as they plan events such as the Administrative Professionals Day Luncheon and the Rainsville Scholarship Golf Tournament.

A full board is 18 persons. To qualify, persons must be an employee, owner or trustee at a member business, or be an individual member which

could be a retired person or simply a concerned citizen. The current board is made up of six business owners, four sales persons, a banker, a plant manager, a store manager, a college advisor and two other individuals. See them at the "about us" page at www.rainsville.info.

Steady growth continues for golf tournament, scholarship program

The Rainsville Chamber launched its scholarship program in 2000. It awarded a \$500 scholarship to one Plainview High School student that year. In 2016, the Chamber awarded four \$1,500 scholarships for the second year in a row—three at PHS and one at Cornerstone Christian Academy. A total of \$21,000 in scholarships has been awarded from 2012 to 2016.

The healthy growth of the

scholarship program is due to growing support for the program's one and only source of funds since 2012, the Rainsville Scholarship Tournament.

This year's tournament was held on August 20 at the Rainsville Golf & Country Club. Over 80 businesses, organizations and individuals sponsored holes, t-shirts, caps and teams, or contributed to the event's success in some other way. Despite a

rainy forecast, a respectable number of golfers came out to compete. And the folks who operate the Rainsville Golf & Country Club once again went above and beyond in regard to preparation and hospitality.

If all pledges are honored, tournament proceeds will exceed last year's results of \$9,500. Proceeds were \$6,600 in 2014, \$4,500 in 2013 and \$3,800 in 2012.

Rainsville Holiday Open House set for November 11-12

Each of the past three Novembers, more than 20 businesses have participated in the annual city-wide Rainsville Holiday Open House. A few new stores have opened since the last one, so the event designed to encourage shoppers to shop locally should provide a one-of-a-kind shopping experience.

New rainsvillealabama.com launched

On September 11th, an all-new rendition of rainsvillealabama.com went live. The site and it’s navigation elements meet current standards for mobile friendliness for the first time. It automatically adjust to the screen it is being viewed on.

features. The old site had many features that were troublesome for a few people to find. For example, too few people even knew that there were pages where you could find city council minutes or ordinances, a page featuring available industrial sites, or a section with city government job postings. But, now those and other sections should be hard to miss.

The Rainsville Chamber has provided the official Rainsville website in some form since about 1998.
